Annenberg Learner

The Annenberg Learner is a multimedia resource for K-12 classroom instruction and teacher professional development. It is available on the ESU 8 SNAP (http://snap.esu8.org) page. Last month, each resource on the SNAP page was listed in the newsletter with a brief description. Beginning this month, I will highlight one of these online resources each month in more detail.

The Annenberg Learner site has two main categories: Classroom Resources and Professional Development.

The subjects within the Classroom Resources tab and the Professional Development tab include: Arts, Education, English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies & History, STEM/STEAM, and World Languages. In each of those two categories, you can either search a specific topic, using a grade level filter and even a subject filter, or you can scroll down to see specific resources/sites sorted by the subjects listed above.
