This behavior program supports students with disabilities (on an IEP) in grades K-6, unlocking their potential by working collaboratively with stakeholders and meeting students where they are academically, behaviorally, and socially to build on their strengths to successfully transition back to their prior educational environment.

If you have any students that you would potentially like to attend our behavior school, we have a process to follow. The process starts with observations and recommendations from Toni Arehart. It is an IEP team decision that ultimately decides the placement of the students along with educational input, academic and behavioral data, an FBA (Functional Behavior Assessment completed by your school psychologist), the student's progress with a BIP (Behavior Intervention Plan), and more.
